Letter from Executive Director

Dear Friends,

It has been an accomplished and unpredictable year! The Yellow Springs Community Children's Center continues to provide a nurturing, family-oriented environment to support and enhance the unique social, intellectual, emotional, and physical growth of each child. Our main goal for the 2019-2020 school year was to ensure that we continue to enhance our curriculum instruction, provide updated classroom materials & rich environment for all age groups & abilities, obtain a five star step up to quality star rating, and establish a close connection with our community and donors for financial growth.



In January 2019 we applied and obtained a 1-star rating through Step Up to Quality with our goal for 2020 to be a 5-star quality rated program. Step Up To Quality is a five—star quality rating and improvement system administered by the Ohio Department of Education and the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. SUTQ recognizes and promotes learning and development programs that meet quality program standards that exceed preschool licensing and school age child care licensing health and safety regulations. Step Up to Quality program standards are based on national research identifying standards which lead to improved outcomes for children. We worked closely with 4 C for Children coaches all year in 2019 to ensure that our teachers and administrators were working in the right direction to obtain a 5-star rating and through careful planning, trainings and hard work, YSCCC was awarded a 5 star by March of 2020! Such a great accomplishment!

With the help of parent collaboration, we were able to put together a comprehensive new marketing program and website to help drive our enrollment numbers up! We partnered with Dayton Parent magazine that gave us marketing space to advertise our camp and preschool program. We saw a 3% increase in tours & enrollment by the end of the year and we were able to start mapping out the opening of another preschool room in hopes to officially open by April of 2020.

As we celebrated a HUGE award for obtaining a 5 Star Step Up to Quality Rating and an increase in enrollment numbers, no one could have prepared for the 2020 pandemic that nearly shutdown our country and drove us into a financial spin in March 2020. The state gave us the option of operating as a pandemic center to serve essential workers or shut down. For the

health and safety of our families and staff, YSCCC made the decision to shut down.14 employees were furloughed and I was unsure of how this pandemic would affect our enrollment, financial security & staff retention. Nearly two months later, YSCCC made a plan to return that followed strict guidelines put in place by ODJFS & CDC to ensure that healthy and safety is a priority.

As we continue operate at half capacity, YSCCC strives to ensure that quality interactions & developmentally appropriate education remains an important component to our mission. This year we will focus on continuing to raise funds for our new HVAC system, upgrade classroom materials and furniture, become experts in Conscious Discipline and keep health and safety in mind amid the pandemic uncertainties.
